PROGRAM BENEFITS



The FAS International Agricultural Fellowship Program (IAFP) plans to award fellowships up to \$42,000 annually for a two-year graduate program at a U.S. university toward tuition, room, board, books, and mandatory fees for completion of Agribusiness or Agricultural Economic degrees.



Fellows will participate in an orientation at Howard University to familiarize themselves with all aspects of the fellowship and enhance their preparation for a career in the Foreign Service.



Fellows will participate in two internships. The first is an internship working at the Foreign Agricultural Service headquarters in Washington, D.C. The second internship will be an overseas placement in a U.S. Embassy or Consulate.

ELIGIBILITY

- U.S. citizenship
- 3.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Intent to seek admission to a two-year, full-time, on-campus master's degree program in Agribusiness or Agricultural Economics at a U.S. graduate institution beginning Fall 2024.
